Copyright Guidelines

- When performing with the score, students may photocopy pages to facilitate page turns, but must also have the published edition with them at the piano.
- Students may read music from a digital device if the music is in the public domain or they have permission from the publisher to make a digital reproduction. (Proof of purchase is required.)
- Published music that was purchased online and downloaded to a digital device is allowed. (Proof of purchase or proof of studio license is required.)
- Music that is in the public domain is allowed. (Verification of public domain status is required.)
- Published music that was purchased online, downloaded and printed is allowed. (Proof of purchase is required.)
- Music printed from CD Sheet Music is allowed. (Display of CD Sheet Music Logo is required.
- Photocopied music that is out of print is allowed. (Written permission from the publisher is required.)
